Such assets shall be utilized by the Board for such objects in the area as it may consider to be for the benefit of the producers of that area.

(3) After the date of issue of such notification or from such later date as may be specified therein, no person, unless exempted by rules made under this Act, shall, either for himself or on behalf of another person or of the State Government within the notified market area, set up, establish or continue or allow to be continued any place for the purchase, sale, storage and processing of the agricultural produce so notified, or purchase, sell, store or process such agricultural produce except under a licence granted in accordance with the passed by the (Secretary of the Board) and the Secretary of the Board if such order is passed by the Chairman of the committee.

[10- A. Certain persons to be licensees

Any persons to whom a licence is granted under section 10 shall be deemed to be licensee under that section for the purposes this Act and the rules made there under including that of levy of fees under section 23 on the agricultural produce bought or sold by him in the notified market area, irrespective of the fact whether the business of buying or selling of agricultural produce is specified in his licence or not].

11. Establishment of Market Committee
