Procedure for levy and Collection of Market fee</p>	<p><u>Section 21 (1)</u> Every Market Committee shall levy and collect a cess on the agricultural produce bought or sold in the market area at a rate not exceeding two rupees for every one hundred rupees of the aggregate amount for which a specified agricultural produce is bought or sold whether for cash or for deferred payment or other valuable considerations.</p> <p>(2) The Assam State Agricultural Marketing Board shall also have the power to levy and collect cess for any or all of the Market Committee (s) in the market areas in addition to the powers of the Market Committee (but not both), whenever felt necessary with approval off the State Government, on agricultural produce bought or sold in such market area (s) at a rate not exceeding two rupees for every one hundred rupees of aggregate amount for which a specified agricultural produce is bought or sold whether for cash or for deferred payment or other valuable considerations.</p> <p>(3) No cess will be levied on goods manufactured from the agricultural produce on which cess is proposed to be levied and which are ultimately exported out of the Country.</p> <p>Explanation – 1. [For the purpose of this section all Specified Agricultural Produce shall unless the contrary is proved be deemed to be bought or sold in notified market area if –</p> <p>Such produce is taken out or proposed to taken out of the said area; or the agreement of sale or purchase thereof in respect of such produce is entered into the said area; or</p> <p>in pursuance of sale or purchase or the agreement of sale or purchase such produce is delivered in the said area to the purchaser or to some other person on behalf of the purchaser.]</p> <p>Explanation – 2.
